February 15, 2019.

1. Scholarship to be awarded to a graduating senior who is a current member of the Texas Junior Livestock Association.

II. SPECIAL CONDITIONS

- 1. Must have been a member of the Texas Junior Livestock Association for at least four (4) years.
- 2. Must have entered and participated in at least three Fall Classic's and three Belt Buckle Bonanza's.
- 3. Must have a GPA of 3.0 or above or an 80 or above grade point average depending on the system used by your high school.

The applications will be judged based on activities and involvement with the TJLA (60%), academics (20%) and involvement in other youth activities (20%).
